



Undergraduate Fixed Rate Tuition Plan

The UNT **Save and Soar** Tuition plan is designed to encourage continuous enrollment and to offer discounts to students throughout their enrollment. By staying continuously enrolled, students can graduate on time and save money.

New Undergraduate Freshmen and Transfer students classified as Texas residents have the option to select the **Save and Soar** Tuition Plan.

What are the benefits?

Save and Soar offers a fixed rate plan for Board Designated Tuition, which includes any Differential Tuition assessed to students. The rates assessed for the student's first year are up to 2% higher than the Traditional Tuition Plan. However, those rates will not change for 4 years.

Save and Soar participants enrolled in 14 semester credit hours* during the fall semester can receive a discount of \$100 per semester credit hour in Board Designated Tuition for enrollment in the winter session.

Participants enrolled in 14 semester credit hours* during the spring semester can receive a discount of \$100 per semester credit hour in Board Designated Tuition for enrollment in the summer semester.

Participants classified as first-time freshmen living in UNT Housing and enrolled in 14 semester credit hours* in the spring semester will receive a 40% discount on housing rates during their first summer semester.

**Minimum hour requirement decreased from 15 to 14 semester credit hours beginning in fall 2020.*
