## Fact Sheet

### How does the program work?

The UNT **Save and Soar** Tuition plan is designed to encourage continuous enrollment and to offer discounts to students throughout their enrollment. By staying continuously enrolled, students can graduate on time and save money.

Beginning with the Fall 2019 semester, new Undergraduate Freshmen and Transfer students classified as Texas residents have the option to select the **Save and Soar** Tuition Plan. Out-of-state or international students receiving a waiver for tuition purposes are not eligible.

### What are the benefits?

**Save and Soar** offers a fixed rate plan for Board Designated Tuition, which includes any Differential Tuition assessed to students. The rates assessed for the student's first year are up to 2% higher than the Traditional Tuition Plan. However, those rates will not change for 4 years.

**Save and Soar** participants enrolled in 15 semester credit hours during the fall semester can receive a discount of \$100 per semester credit hour in board designated tuition for enrollment in the winter session.

Participants enrolled in 15 semester credit hours during the spring semester can receive a discount of \$100 per semester credit hour in board designated tuition for enrollment in the summer semester.

Participants classified as first-time freshmen living in UNT Housing and enrolled in 15 semester credit hours in the spring semester will receive a 40% discount on housing rates during their first summer semester.

**How do I select the Save and Soar Tuition Plan?**

Students are provided an opportunity to select the **Save and Soar** Tuition Plan when viewing their tuition and fee bill at my.unt.edu. A selection must be made before the student's first payment deadline in their first semester.

**Can I change my tuition plan after I make my selection?**

Students can update their tuition plan before their first payment deadline in their first semester. Once payment is finalized, they are locked into their tuition plan for 4 years.

**Am I required to enroll in a minimum number of hours each semester if I select the Save and Soar Tuition Plan?**

No. However, students must enroll in 15 semester credit hours for the fall and/or spring semester to take advantage of the discounts in the following winter session or summer semester.

**Will the tuition rates increase for the Traditional Plan?**

We cannot guarantee the rates will increase in future years. However, historically, the rates have gradually increased. By selecting the **Save and Soar** Tuition Plan, students are not subject to increases in Board Designated Tuition or Differential Tuition for 4 years.

**What happens if I select the Save and Soar Tuition Plan and do not graduate in 4 years?**

After the 4<sup>th</sup> year, the student would be placed in the Traditional Tuition Plan and be assessed the current rates for tuition and fees. There would be no penalty or adjustment to their charges for the previous 4 years.

**What if I am currently participating in the Eagle Express Tuition Plan?**

The option of selecting the Eagle Express Tuition Plan ended in Summer 2019. Current participants will have their Eagle Express tuition and fees locked in through their designated 4<sup>th</sup> year and will remain eligible to qualify for the graduation incentive.
